




WORKING GROUP STRUCTURE




PREPARATORY PROCESS

<i>ACTION 3: Apply Nature based solutions including green infrastructure to improve water quality and resources</i>	<i>Project 2 - Implement local Nature-based solutions for domestic wastewater treatment (Morroco) - Status : Already launched</i>
<i>ACTION 4: Implement sanitation systems adapted to local contexts that meet standards by prioritising the reuse of by-products (circular economy)</i>	<i>Project 1 - ONAS - Sénégal: Public toilets' installations and water reuse in Dakar, Senegal</i>

Evaluation of consultation proposals

Consideration of feedback on actions will be based on:

- Consistency with the objectives of the action
- Potential overlaps with other actions
- The added value of the suggestions

Requests for contributions to existing projects will be reviewed on the basis of:

- Consistency with the objectives and expected results of the projects
- Regional representativeness in the project
- Any other added value of the proposals

Criteria for the evaluation of suggested new projects:

- Alignment of the projects with the objectives of the targeted Action
- Overlaps with other projects
- Representativeness of stakeholders and actors involved
- Regional Representation


